Mission

Durham Children's Aid Foundation is committed to collaborating with the community to enable equal opportunities for children, youth, and families, so that they may reach their full potential.

Vision

Every child or youth, regardless of circumstances, has the resources and support to reach their full potential.

DCAF provided revenues and gifts totally **over \$733,000** to support programs like the Bursary Program, Technology, Mentoring for Success, Holiday Hope, and a new Family Assistance Fund amongst others.

This achievement and success were only possible with the support from our community partners and donors.

2022/23 IN REVIEW

The Foundation had some memorable moments this year:

July 2022, we held our second **Rings of Hope** event – this year it grew from a drive-thru event to an in-person celebration of diversity, equity and inclusion. It raised over \$10K for the Foundation and served as an opportunity to engage the community and showcase some of our local talent.

- **September 2022**, we held our annual **Fore the Future Golf Classic**, it was a fantastic event and the Foundation raised over \$47,000 for the Bursary program.
- **December 2022**, DCAF was presented an award of appreciation by RBC for community efforts supporting Black History Events and the Black Community in Durham Region.
- December 2022, we assisted 571 families including 100 Ukrainian Families and 36 Community Outreach Families. In total, over 1100 children and youth were provided the gift of HOPE through our Holiday Hope program. The entire team pulled together to execute this important and demanding initiative. DCAF also acknowledges and thanks all our dedicated and hardworking volunteers and sponsors; without your help, this program isn't possible!



To continue the legacy of Sharon's Kids, a program founded by the late Sharon Clark, the Oshawa Assembly at General Motors Canada and its dealers donated **\$382,000** to DCAF's **Holiday Hope** Program.

GM Canada held a dealer contest for the opportunity to purchase the first 2023 Chevrolet Corvette Z06 built for Canada, raising **\$253,000** for DCAF through donations from 106 GM dealers. The winning dealer was Lakewood Chevrolet in Edmonton, Alberta and will purchase a Torch Red Corvette Z06 Convertible 3LZ.

The donated funds to DCAF consisted of monetary donations from the GM Canada dealer contest, a **\$20,000** donation from Oshawa Assembly through the Plant City Grant Program and more than **\$40,000** for hampers from GM Canada employees.


