The Sharon Clark Volunteer of the Year Award recognizes an exceptional volunteer whose compassion, reliability, and dedication reflect the enduring spirit of Sharon Clark, Founder of Sharon's Kids and the inspiration behind Holiday Hope.

In the 1970s, while working at General Motors, Sharon sparked a movement by suggesting that employees give their holiday gifts to children in need instead of each other. That simple idea grew into Sharon's Kids the foundation of what is now Durham Children's Aid Foundation's Holiday Hope program, bringing dignity and joy to more than 1,000 children and youth each year.



This award honours volunteers who embody that same belief that kindness and community can change lives. Nominees may contribute through events, mentorship, family support, or in-kind coordination, but all share Sharon's unwavering spirit of generosity and care.

Any active DCAF or DCAS volunteer who gives their time, talent, and energy to support children, youth, or families.
